At the heart of all of Kevin's work is a strong sense of philanthropy and giving. Since his company's foundation, he has committed to giving 5% of annual profits each year to charity. He is a trustee of Elizabeth's Legacy of Hope (ELOH), a charity supporting child amputees across the world. Kevin has contributed over £50,000 of support to this charity since its inception. In 2012, Kevin was nominated to carry the Olympic Torch through London, in recognition of his work with ELOH. Kevin has also raised thousands of pounds for Trinity Hospice, the hospice that cared for his mother before her passing in 2012.
